These items will help you a lot in the fight against King Asgore. There are two keys on the upper floors of the house. Search the rooms for keys and be sure to search for items for some extra stories. Unstret the chain to the basement and go down. A familiar character stops by the way for a short conversation and some information about the true nature of the game that will blow your mind. Pacifist boss tips: King Asgore There is no way to peacefully end this fight. You must fight King Asgore. Make sure it is full of healing elements and is equipped with the most powerful weapon and armor. This battle will be very, very difficult if you are stuck in the pacifist checklist. Be sure to make a butterscotch pie with your inventory for this battle. Using it reduces Asgore's ATK and DEF for the duration of the battle. You can also talk to him 3 times to reduce the ATK and DEF. King Asgore's attacks are very similar to Toriel's, but they show no mercy. Sometimes he uses a colorful attack, prevented by his eyes. If you see orange, you need to move during the attack, if they are blue, you need to sit still. Try to avoid attacks as much as possible and attack him all the time; Eventually, he'll kneel, and the fight will be over. Now you have the opportunity to spare or kill King Asgore. You have to spare him to reveal the true ending. An old friend visits, and things start... Strange. Pacifist Boss Tips: Flowey Once Flowey appears, things start to get completely crazy. The game crashes and reopens in flowey's nightmare world. It will mutate into a God-like killing machine, triggering the final battle of neutral play. The Flowey boss battle is long, difficult, and annoying. His attacks are inevitable and permanent, but they don't do much damage. Dodge as the best you can, but expect to hit you often. Attack all options given in advance of the next stage of the battle. Flowey's summoning his soul to attack you now, but you can use them to your advantage. You need to find the Law button and activate it to turn white, harmful attacks green, healing attacks. There are 6 souls to pass through; When completed, combine their powers to reduce Flowey DEF to 0 and allow you to finish off this arse. Avoid attacks as best you can and attack with every opportunity to end the battle. You can Kill or Reserve Flowey; does not affect the achievement of True Ending. English Share ASGORE Attacks! On the neutral route, before the fight begins, Asgore destroys the MERCY button. While on the genocide route, the MERCY button has been It mainly attacks with fireballs, and Asgore forces the protagonist to fight him, and the protagonist does not spare Asgore. If Asgore's attacks hit the protagonist and they don't have enough HP to survive, the attack will reduce HP to 1 when he would otherwise have killed them. However, the next attack that hits the main character will kill them. This is similar to Toriel's refusal to hurt a man if HP ever drops to 2, but also decides to intentionally miss the protagonist. To reduce Asgore AT and DF, the protagonist can eat a piece of butterscotch pie in battle or talk to Asgore three times. Talking about Asgore only reduces the stats when the protagonist is 0 EXP. This may indicate that someone is sensitively familiar. During the battle, Asgore uses attack patterns similar to Toriel's. He also
